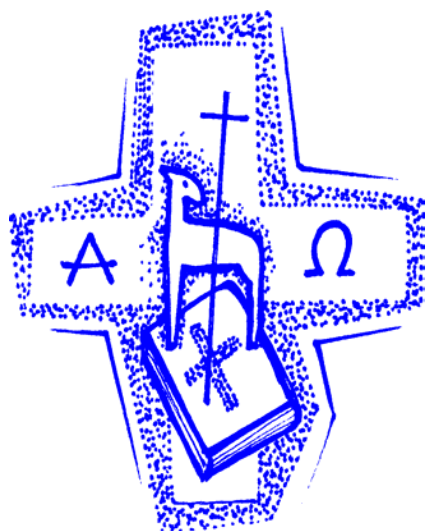

## **HOLY DAYS**

Days marked in **Bold** type are obligatory and are kept with their own Collect, Readings and Post Communion Prayer.

Ferial days in ordinary type follow the order of the Daily Eucharistic Lectionary for the season or Ordinary Time.

Days in *italic* type are memorials and the Collect and Readings follow the order of the Daily Eucharistic Lectionary. Where the President thinks it appropriate alternative readings and collects may be used.

## **COLOURS**

The colours refer to the altar hangings and the vestments, which should always match.

## **NUMBERS**

- Where collect and post communion prayers are followed by a number this refers to the Collect number in “The New Calendar and Collects” and the *page number* also refers to pages in “The New Calendar and Collects.”
- A number following a reference to a eucharistic preface refers to the Preface Number in “An Alternative Order for the Holy Eucharist 2004”

## **FLOWERS AND OTHER DECORATIONS**

**There should be no flowers in church during the seasons of Advent and Christmas.** However, to celebrate the solemnities of **St David** and **The Annunciation**, which often occur during Lent, a vase (or vases) of flowers may be brought into church and removed at the end of the mass.

At Christmastide the church may be decorated when the last Advent mass has been said in the church, but certainly not before that time.

The Christmas crib may similarly be put into place following the celebration of the last Advent mass in each church.

**In Advent 2008** this means that churches may be decorated as follows

Holy Trinity                      *after the Mass on Sunday 21st December*

St. Mary's                        *after the Mass on Sunday 21st December*

St. Agnes'                        *after the Mass on Monday 22nd December*

St. Paul's                         *after the Mass on Tuesday 23rd December*

*There will be no masses in the morning of Christmas Eve.*

**At Easter 2009** no flowers may be placed in any church until the end of the Good Friday services in that church.

## **COLOURS**

Where possible the church should be decorated in white flowers for Christmas and Easter, with yellow to help break up the monotony.

**The Advent wreath** should, where possible, be made from holly and ivy, and should stand in a place where it may be seen clearly, but in a position where it does not obscure the altar or tabernacle.

**At Christmastide great care must be taken that the tree should not be gaudy,** and gold decorations are to be preferred in keeping with the colour of the season. The tree must be placed in a position where it does not obscure the altar or tabernacle.

Red flowers on a green background should be used sparingly, as the arrangement can appear dark and not give the church the joyful appearance of the season.
