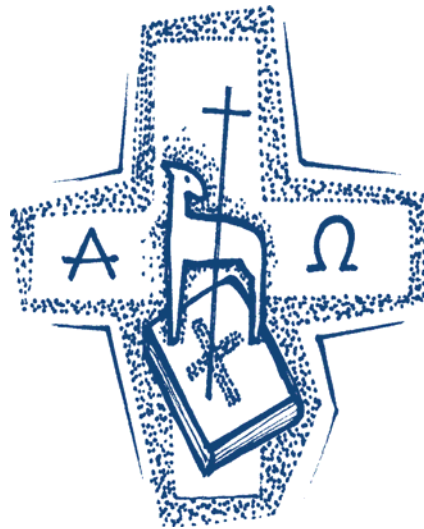

## Memorias and Feasts

Optional memoria and feasts are kept with their own collect and the continued cycle of weekday readings. Optional memoria are omitted during Lent to continue the flow of the seasonal material.

## Holy Days

Days marked in **Bold** type are obligatory and are kept with their own Collect, Readings and Post Communion Prayer.

Readings are from the Lectionaries Volume I or II unless otherwise stated.

When *Exciting Holiness* is needed at the Lectern it will be written alongside the day in this calendar and lectionary

## Psalm verses

The verses referred to in the psalms are those from the Common Worship psalter and do not necessarily conform to the NRSV translation of the Bible from where the other Scriptural texts are taken.

For the purposes of singing they are modified to correspond to *New Psalms for Common Worship* by Colin Mawby

## Sunday Readings in Ordinary Time

Following Trinity Sunday we follow Track 2 of the Church in Wales Lectionary for the Sunday Mass (known as 'related' in Common Worship)

## Flowers and other decorations

There should be no flowers in church during the seasons of Advent and Lent. However, to celebrate the solemnities of St David and The Annunciation, which often occur during Lent, a vase (or vases) of flowers may be brought into church and removed at the end of the mass.

**The Advent wreath** should, where possible, be made from holly and ivy, and should stand in a place where it may be seen clearly, but in a position where it does not obscure the altar or tabernacle.

**At Christmastide** the church may be decorated when the last Advent mass has been said in the church, but certainly not before that time. The Christmas crib may similarly be put into place following the celebration of the last Advent mass in each church. It must not be placed in front of the altar.

Great care must be taken that the tree should not be gaudy, and gold decorations are to be preferred in keeping with the colour of the season.

The tree must be placed in a position where it does not obscure the altar or tabernacle.

There will be no masses in the morning of Christmas Eve.

**At Easter 2012** no flowers may be placed in any church until the end of the Good Friday services in that church.

### Colours for flowers

Where possible the church should be decorated in white flowers for Christmas and Easter, with yellow to help break up the monotony.

At Christmas especially, red flowers on a green background should be used sparingly, as the arrangement can appear dark and not give the church the joyful appearance of the season.
